	6. We open your ballot Ballots are removed from envelopes, taken to a secure room, scanned into a closed computer network that is not internet accessible, and stored until the polls close on Election Day.	
	7. We check your ballot If a ballot is damaged, has stray marks, corrections, or if the wrong type of pen was used, a team of election judges uses our high-resolution ballot imaging software and the Voter Intent Guide produced by the Office of the Secretary of State to resolve the ballot.	
	8. We count your ballot After the polls close at 7 p.m. on Election Day, the images of the scanned ballots are counted by a tabulation machine.
