Required Information

The following information is required as part of the 1041 WOGLA Application. Provide relevant, site-specific information that addresses each topic. If a topic does not pertain to the Oil and Gas Location being proposed, provide an explanation as to why the topic does not apply.

- A. Indicate if the proposed Oil and Gas Location is located within an Overlay District Area or a Special Flood Hazard Area identified by maps officially adopted by the Weld County. Describe any additional permits or mitigation measures necessary to comply with Article V and Article XI of Chapter 23 of the Weld County Code.
- B. Describe the alternative Site Analysis used to select the proposed Oil and Gas Location. Include information describing the sites that were identified during the pre-application meeting and discuss the pros and cons of each site. Identify the factors that led to the proposed site being chosen, including minimizing impact on agricultural operations.
- C. Provide detailed information about the topics below demonstrating how the proposed Oil and Gas Location will comply with Chapter 21, Article V, Division 4 of the Weld County Code. Include a description of site-specific Best Management Practices (BMPs) and other mitigation measures to be used.
 - 1. Describe plans for controlling weeds on the Oil and Gas Location in accordance with Sec. 21-5-400.
 - 2. Describe plans for visual impact mitigation in accordance with Sec. 21-5-410.
 - 3. Describe fugitive dust control measures in accordance with Sec. 21-5-415. Indicate whether the Oil and Gas Location is subject to a Road Maintenance Agreement with Weld County or if a Cash in Lieu payment was applied. If a Dust Mitigation Plan is required, then the provided plan will replace the need for this statement.
 - 4. Describe the site security measures that will be implemented at the proposed Oil and Gas Location in accordance with Sec. 21-5-425. Include information describing how facilities will be designed to operate in a manner that protects public health and safety during all phases of operation by preventing unauthorized access and illegal dumping of wastes. Describe any signage, fencing or screening that is planned.
 - 5. Describe the noise mitigation measures that will be used in accordance with the noise limits set forth in Sec. 21-5-435 during the Construction Phase and Production Phases. If a Noise Mitigation Plan is required, then the provided plan will replace the need for this statement.
 - 6. Describe the methods used to control odors and air pollutant emissions from the proposed Oil and Gas Facilities. Reference relevant state and federal air requirements and address all common sources of odor and regulated pollutants. Include a description of the Leak Detection and Repair (LDAR) program and Ozone mitigation plans for the site. Indicate if the Oil and Gas Location is covered by a written LDAR and Ozone mitigation plan and if a copy has previously been provided to OGED. If a Odor Mitigation Plan is required, then the provided plan will replace the need for this statement.
 - 7. Describe how the proposed Oil and Gas Location will comply with the Colorado Water Quality Control Commission regulations. Include the applicable CDPHE Construction Stormwater Permit number(s).

- 8. Describe any additional measures that will be implemented to minimize adverse environmental impacts and protect public health, safety and welfare, including the environment and Wildlife Resources.
- D. Please provide a description of the kind of vehicles (type, size, weight) that will access the Oil and Gas Location during drilling and completion operations and define the haul route. This description shall include the following information:
 - 1. The number of round trips/day (Round trip = 1 trip in and 1 trip out) expected for each vehicle (type, size, weight) passenger cars/pickups, tandem trucks, semi-truck/trailer/RV.
 - 2. The routes vehicles will travel from the access of the Oil and Gas Location to the nearest county designated arterial or collector roadway or state highway.
 - 3. The travel distribution along the identified haul routes (e.g. 50% of traffic will come from the north, 20% from the south, 30% from the east, etc.).
 - 4. The time of day when the highest traffic volumes are expected.
