February 23, 2026

The Weld County Council met in regular session in full conformity with the Weld County Home Rule Charter at 6:30 p.m., Monday, February 23, 2026, at the Weld County Administration Building, 1150 0 Street, Greeley, CO.

ROLL CALL:

The meeting was called to order by President Elijah Hatch. Councilmembers Jeff Reck and Terry DeGroot were present, constituting a quorum of members. Councilmembers Nancy Teksten and James Welch had excused absences. Also present was Council Secretary Linda Kane.

County Attorney Bruce Barker said his office has nine assistant county attorneys who practice general law and child welfare cases.

They represent all divisions and departments of county government. The county has a contract attorney and an attorney who assists the Area Agency on Aging, elderly care and adult protection.

The county attorney's office provides some defense on cases in state court and they do quite a bit of work on zoning enforcement.

Mr. Barker's office also provides a lot of advice to the county commissioners and a lot of legislative work on bills coming before commissioners.

Councilmember DeGroot made a motion to approve bills, it was seconded by Councilmember Reck and carried. The bills were paid as follows:



By acclamation, the meeting was adjourned at 7:14 p.m.


