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ISSUE: Currently, public outreach communication in the City of Dacono is split between internal employees and external consultants. This can be challenging in terms of coordinating messages, both around community outreach about hazards and preparedness, and during a disaster or large-scale emergency.

RECOMMENDATION: A newly funded position, Community Relations Coordinator, is proposed to coordinate all communication. This position will serve as the single point of contact to communicate to the public and all media outlets during a crisis or disaster and will enable the City of Dacono to provide a unified voice and trusted source for information about hazards, a well as fully participate in Carbon Valley public information and outreach groups.
