
Impaired and Distracted Driving





Impaired driving is a major contributor to fatal and serious injury crashes—within Weld County, 1 in 5 of these crashes involved drugs or alcohol. In rural areas of Weld County, alcohol-related deaths are **more than double** those in jurisdictions in the action plan.

In Colorado in 2024, 10% of crashes involved a distracted driver. In rural Weld County, 13% of KSI crashes involved a distracted driver.
