Transit Plan Update

- Coordinated Public Transit & Human Services Transportation Plan (“Transit Plan”)
- Created in coordination with transit agencies of the TPR and contains an inventory of existing interregional, regional, and local transit providers that provide services within the TPR
- Federal Transit Administration (FTA) requirement to receive federal transit funding
- To be published as appendix to Regional Transportation Plan
- Upcoming: Survey for Older Adults & Adults with Disabilities

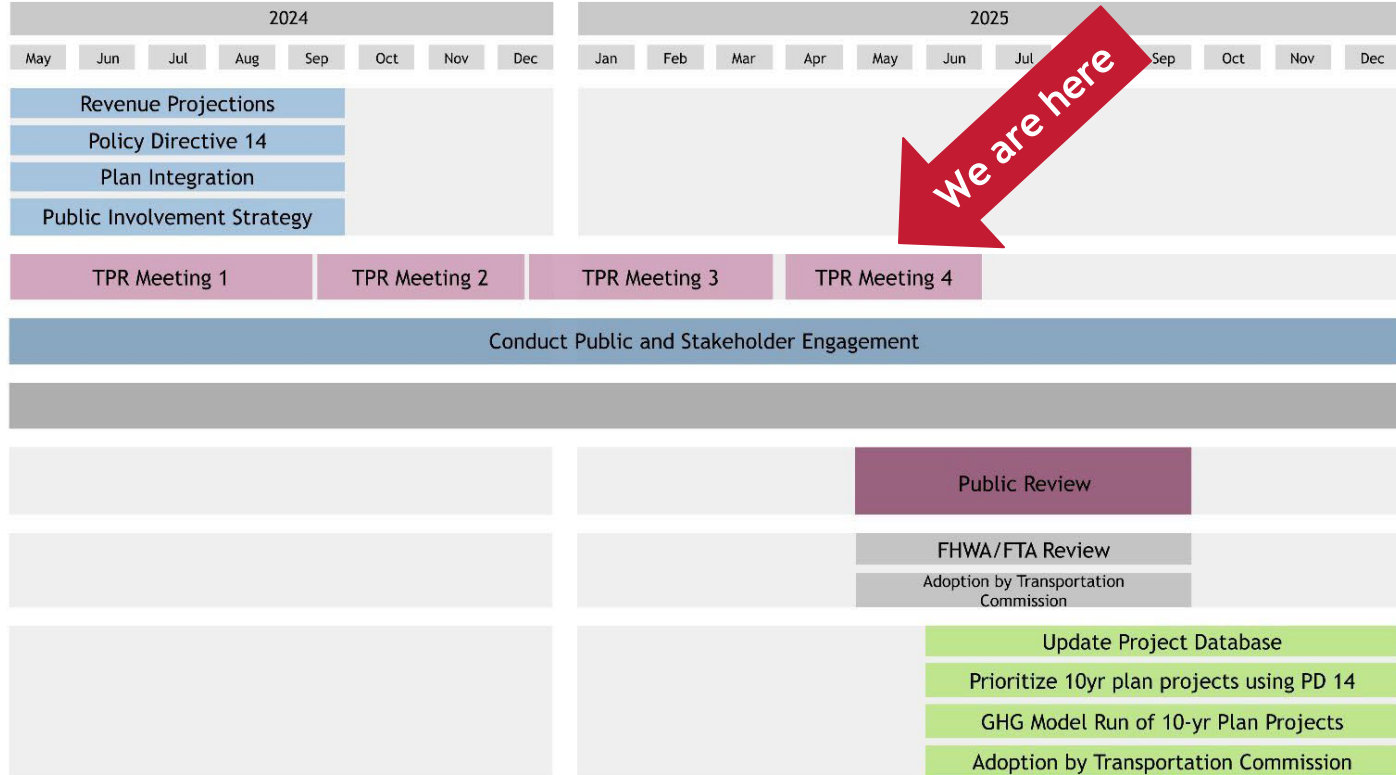
2050 Statewide and Regional Plan Timeline
