INFORMATIONAL MEETING ON JUNE 13TH

Weld County Public Works, the Board of County Commissioners, as well as representatives from the towns of Severance, Eaton, Ault, Pierce, and Nunn, will be hosting an informational meeting to discuss the WCR 29 Access Control Plan (ACP) and gather feedback on access inventory maps from property owners on the corridor.

This meeting will take place Tuesday, June 13th, 2017, at 6:00 p.m. in the Events Center Room at the Weld County Administration Building at 1150 O Street, Greeley.

This ACP is being developed for the stretch of WCR 29 between State Highway 392 and WCR 100, and will supplement regulations regarding access to county roads found in the <u>Weld County Code</u> by analyzing safety conditions, existing access, and alternative (side road) access.

The primary goal of the ACP is to improve corridor safety, but it also works to coordinate road improvements, promote economic vitality, protect infrastructure investments, and maintain the functional integrity of the corridor. In short, this ACP is developed to ensure adequate safety, mobility, and capacity on WCR 29.

Due to WCR 29's connectivity to WCR 100, traffic is anticipated to increase on WCR 29. This ACP is a
