We are open **all year** to help children get the immunizations that are required to attend schools and daycare centers.

What are the Child Care/school requirements for reporting aggregate immunization data?

- Some Colorado schools and licensed child cares must report aggregate immunization and exemption data to CDPHE by December 1 of each year (extended to January 15 this year), per the Colorado Board of Health rule 6 CCR 1009-2
- Public, private, and parochial schools with grades K-12, child care centers, preschools and Head Start programs with more than 10 children <u>are required</u> to report.

- No child is turned away for the inability to pay.
- We accept Medicaid, CHP+, Blue Cross Blue Shield, and Cigna.
- Children younger than 18 must be accompanied by a parent or person who has authority to give consent.

What parents should bring:

- Child's current immunization record
- Child's insurance card, if available
