

Tallest Plants in Weld County (that aren't trees or shrubs)

Tall growth among many plants is not uncommon. Herbaceous species can grow exceptionally tall without being a tree or shrub. The tallest non-tree or shrub plants in Weld County are:



Marshelder (up to 8 feet)

Purple Loosestrife (up to 8 feet)



Scotch Thistle (up to 10 feet)

The Knotweeds (up to 10 feet)



Poison Hemlock (up to 10 feet)

Cattails (up to 10 feet)



Cutleaf Teasel (up to 10 feet) Giant Ragweed (up to 13 feet)



Ravenna or Pampas Grass (up to 15 feet)

Phragmites or Common Reed (up to 20 feet)
